A growing need for help...

West Valley Community Services is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that has been providing safety net services to low income and homeless individuals and families in the west valley region of Santa Clara County for **45 years.**

The mission of West Valley Community Services is to unite the community to **fight hunger and homelessness**.

Our work is guided by the vision of a community where **every person has food** on the table and **every person has a roof** over their head.

Here are some highlights from 2017-2018:

- In October 2017, launched RYDE, a senior transportation pilot program serving seniors 55+ in Cupertino, Saratoga, Los Gatos, Monte Sereno and Campbell.
- Expanded the Mobile Food Pantry to the Moreland School District in San Jose.
- Achieved significant program milestones: 53% increase in new clients, 14% increase in children served through the Back to School program, and a 10% increase in clients served through Gift of Hope.

133 children in K-12th grade received clothing, shoes and backpacks



608 people received clothing, toys, and appliances at Gift of Hope



Volunteers helped **82** clients file for **\$120,138** in tax returns



259 families received Thanksgiving meal baskets



1,011 students and individuals were served on the Mobile Food Pantry


